# Nationwide Survey of RCCs – Last Plug!

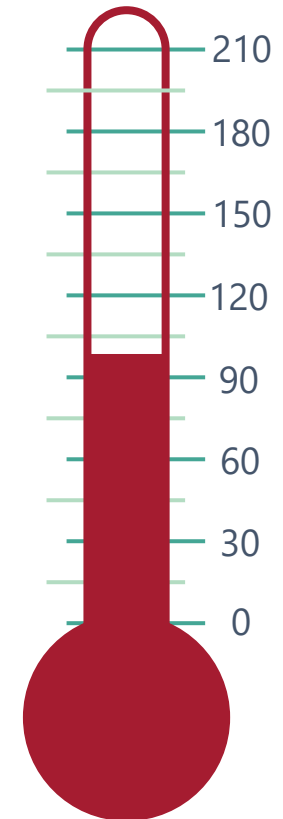


## Goals of this study:

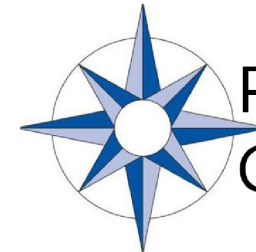


We are featuring a different RCC at the start of each of our seminars in order to allow all participants to learn first-hand about RCCs



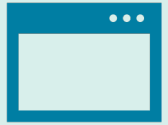
